



Shalom Recovery Centers is a Long-term (36 week) Residential Faith Based Recovery Program for those suffering from alcoholism and addiction. We are also an approved ACC Reentry Facility (3 months). We provide transitional housing, meals, assist with employment and transportation. We provide alcohol and drug education classes, individual and group counseling as well as case management to coordinate medical and mental health care as well as other resources within the community. Our goal is to assist men and women in gaining the ability to live clean and sober, become healthy productive members of society and family reunification.

Our organization serves Men and Women aged 18 or older throughout the state of Arkansas or USA seeking help with alcoholism and addiction in a residential setting. Individual admission may be voluntary, a referral from other care providers or court ordered. The Transitional Housing Program is up to 90 days for those eligible to parole from Arkansas Community Corrections that seek assistance in reintegration into society.

We have a 72-bed capacity. Often clients have suffered homelessness, loss of job, health problems, mental health problems, legal problems, and family problems because of alcoholism and addiction. We provide a safe place including residence, all meals, transportation to all appointments as well as assisting them gain employment within the community. At Shalom we provide substance abuse education and relapse prevention techniques as well as daily living skills. We facilitate getting insurance coverage to begin addressing medical and mental health problems. Clients are encouraged to address all areas of their life so they can live happy and whole and improve their overall wellbeing as they begin working to strengthen their relationship within, with their family and community. Staff walk alongside the client in this process. We attend several church services throughout the week as well as 12-step meetings, anger management, and parenting classes. Many also take advantage of financial management classes that helps them learn how to manage paying bills, fines and fees, savings as well as gaining financial independence.

We understand the journey of recovery is not easy, but we are here for support, encouragement, prayer, and accountability. We believe that God has a very specific plan for everyone who comes to Shalom. God is already working on that plan. Complete healing is possible.

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
