

Shalom Recovery Centers is a long-term (36 week) residential faith-based recovery program for those suffering from alcoholism and addiction. We are also an approved ACC Transitional Facility (3 months). We provide transitional housing, meals, assist with employment and transportation. We provide alcohol and drug education classes, individual and group counseling as well as case management to coordinate medical and mental health care as well as other resources within the community. Our goal is to assist men and women in gaining the ability to live clean and sober, become healthy productive members of society and reunite with their families.

Our organization serves men and women age 18 or older throughout the state of Arkansas and the U.S. seeking help with alcoholism and addiction in a residential setting. Individual admission may be voluntary, a referral from other care providers or court-ordered. The Transitional Housing Program is up to 90 days for those eligible to parole from Arkansas Community Correction that seek assistance in reintegration into society.

We have a 72-bed capacity. Often clients have suffered homelessness, loss of employment and problems with health, the legal system and their own families because of their addiction. We provide a safe place in order for them to recover and begin working on restoring their situation. Clients are encouraged to address all areas of their lives so they can improve their overall well-being. Staff walk alongside the client in this process. We attend several church services throughout the week as well as 12-step meetings, anger management, parenting classes and financial management classes.

We understand the journey of recovery is not easy, but we are here for support, encouragement, prayer, and accountability. We believe that God has a very specific plan for everyone who comes to Shalom. God is already working on that plan. Complete healing is possible.
